The Villa Romana de l'Albir Open-Air Museum is an archaeological space where you can discover first-hand a rural settlement from Roman times that belonged, more than 1,500 years ago, to a family that controlled a large settlement. The excavations carried out since 2008 have made it possible to date the site between the 2nd and 7th centuries AD. It is the first open-air museum in the Valencian Community, having been recognized by the Generalitat Valenciana in March 2011. The Villa Romana de l'Albir Open-Air Museum has a management system that ensures compliance with the requirements of the UNE 302002:2018 standard. The guidelines on which its mission, vision and values are based are:

- Maintain the elements of the site in perfect condition, as well as spread knowledge about it to all citizens.
- Satisfy the needs and expectations of the people who visit the museum, as well
 as the rest of the interested parties, taking into account their opinions to apply
 them as improvement measures.
- Maintain the commitment to quality, through the effective implementation of a continuous improvement system.
- Sign the commitment to improvements in matters of universal accessibility, providing accessible resources to all the museum's facilities.
